### **Organics, Recycling and Garbage**

We all spend time shopping and selecting the goods that we bring into our home. It is very important to also take a bit of time to consider the appropriate way to dispose of these items when we are done with them.

**All ORGANICS** – food type items, plant and animal, go into the **COMPOST / GREEN bins**.

These are items that will rot and smell bad if you just throw them into your garbage / black bins. Nothing else should be placed into the green bins except LABELLED COMPOSTABLE BAGS which are acceptable. Everyone living on Everridge Common is required to keep their garbage bins inside of their garage, so make sure your organics are placed into the green bins outside to keep your garage from smelling.

**All RECYCLABLES** – Cardboard, paper, plastics, etc. go into the **RECYCLABLES / BLUE bins** in the Garbage Garage, or in the Clear Bags provided for those living on Everridge Common, to be put out for Thursday early morning pick-up.

These are items that can be processed for re-use by breaking them down and utilizing the basic materials to manufacture new items. Make sure that you scrape off or rinse out remaining food so that the recycling does not stink and so that these items can be re-used as intended. Make sure that you flatten cardboard boxes, remove any styrofoam inserts (not recyclable) and remove and throw away any bottle caps. Stretchy plastics are all recyclable but cannot be thrown in loose. Fill one plastic bag with all of your stretchy plastics, plastic bags and bubble wrap and tie the top before including these in your recycling.

**All GARBAGE** – Anything that is **NOT** organic, recyclable or hazardous, goes into the **GARBAGE / BLACK bins**.

Remember that any furniture or large items that are not standard household trash, are the unit owners' responsibility and must be donated somewhere or taken to landfill. These are NOT to be left outside of garbage bins or within the Garbage Garage. This results in additional costs to have someone remove and dispose of these items correctly. This additional cost ends up being shared by all unit owners and contributes to higher condo fees. This is not a fair way to treat your neighbors.

Electronics recycling is now available at Fish Creek Bottle Depot – 15216 Shaw Road SE or by taking them to the Customer Service Desk in BEST BUY stores.

The Fire Hall on the corner will accept batteries, propane bottles, some chemical products and items that would be hazardous to include in the trash. Check the building behind the fire hall to see what items they accept there.
